

**Rum River Hills Men's Club
Bill Dorn Scholarship Application Form (2022)**

Who can apply? Any Rum River Hills Men's Club member in good standing can sponsor *himself*, his *spouse*, or his *child*. The sponsor must be a full-pay member of the Men's Club, have qualified for the Club Championship for the previous two consecutive years before applying, and must qualify for the Club Championship the years they apply, are announced, and receive funds.


How much is the scholarship worth? Accepted applicants are eligible for a lifetime award of up to \$1500. If funds are available, the award will be paid in yearly installments of \$750. The sponsor needs to apply only one time.

Restrictions: There is a \$1500 per year limit for any given family and a \$3000 lifetime family maximum. If a student is getting a full scholarship, they are not eligible. You must submit tuition receipts from the school to be able to get the scholarship.

Timeline: Applications must be **postmarked (address below) by Wednesday, February 23, 2022** or placed in the tournament box by 5 P.M. on Sunday, February 27. Awards will be announced at the Spring Meeting on April 12 (or in an online scholarship report). The applicant must complete the coursework in the 2022-2023 academic year. The applicant must submit receipts showing payment for tuition and course fees along with a transcript showing that a 2.0+ GPA, or its equivalent, has been earned. The applicant must submit all documentation by August 1, 2023 (and then on August 1, 2024 for the next year), or the scholarship is forfeited for that year. Scholarship checks are made out to the applicant and can be picked up by the sponsor.
